1. Title/Statement of Purpose: The title or purpose of the display should have a clear statement outlining the display's aim.	5	
2. Scope of Display & Labelling: Within the display, each exhibit should tell the story of the artifact(s) with attention to the following points:		
a. The importance or educational value of the display. Why the display is worth looking at and its importance to the viewer.	15	
b. Does the description of the display materials answer as many as possible of Who, What, Where, When & Why? Should reveal something of the amount and degree of difficulty of research.	20	
c. Do the materials displayed show some special nature either in and of itself or in terms of a special time, event or circumstance?	10	
d. Additional technical information, such as physical characteristics, symbolism, design, manufacturing data, etc.	5	
3. Physical appearance and presentation: The overall display should be attractive, interesting, attention-getting and be viewer appealing.		
a. The artful and visually pleasing arrangement of materials.	5	
b. Demonstration of originality, imagination and innovation in the presentation of the materials and supporting information.	10	
c. Completeness and comprehensiveness of the overall display in terms of its stated purpose as in the title, including the use of supporting materials such as photos, documents, etc.	15	
d. Form of labels: complete, accurate, brief, neat and readable.	5	
e. Condition of both the overall display and the individual items within it, including any supporting material, both of which should be of the highest reasonable standard, consideration for evidence of responsible conservation and preservation techniques.	10
